Translation:

govinda: A name for the youthful Krishna. Literally,
the lord of the cows (“go”).

jai/jaya: Victory to! Celebration of. An emphatic
“Hooray God!”

gopāla: A name for the divine baby Krishna.
Literally, shepherd of the cows (“go”).

rādhā ramaṇa: A name of Krishna, meaning the one
who delights in Radha.

hari: A name of Vishnu. Literally “the remover,” as
in the One who removes all suffering and all veils
of ignorance.
